STRATEGIC GOALS OF THE CARO-KANN 17 STRATEGIC GOALS OF THE CARO-KANN Black's goals in the Caro-Kann Defense are to contest the center and to develop without creating major weaknesses First of all, Black will develop pieces as quickly as possible As White's pawns advance further up the board they become possible liabilities in the endgame
